DUCK AND GOOSE HUNTING REGULATIONS FOR BAY BEACH SHORELINE AND SOUTHWEST SHORELINE TO KEN EUERS NATURE CENTER. INCLUDES EARLY GOOSE SEASON 1 SEPTEMBER – 15 SEPTEMBER 2007

- 1. The early Goose season is set to open 1 September 07 and run through 15 September 07. In accordance with present regulations hunters can set up blinds 7 days prior to the opening date (Wednesday August 25th)This is a DNR matter and any complaints or concerns should be called into the local DNR warden.
- 2. Any hunting in or out of an established blind must be done where there is standing water and natural vegitation. Any blind in standing water without natural vegitation is considered an open water blind and must be 500 feet from shore. In addition any blind must display the owners name, address and DNR customer number. This applies even if the area a hunter was using washes out over night. Dry areas or "washouts" in front of Bay Beach even if they are not permanent are considered within the city boundaries of the City of Green Bay. Hunters may be cited for discharging a firearm within the city limits. The issue of hunting while not in the water is to be referred to the Green Bay Police Department. All other waterfowl blind issues should be reported to the local DNR warden.
- 3. Hunters may hunt right up to the waterline along the City of Green Bay. This includes the Bay Beach shoreline, the shoreline in front of the industrial park up to and including the Ken Euers Nature Center on the west side. They must however be 200 feet away from the waterline where it is zoned residential (any area directly in front of houses).
- 4. All guns must be cased and unloaded when within city limits at all times. With a cased and unloaded gun hunters can use the city parking lots and walkways to get to their destination. This is a city ordinance and any observed violations should be reported to the Green Bay Police Department.
- 5. Hunters must have due regard for safety by firing out toward the water and not toward Bay Beach Park or any houses. A disorderly conduct citation may be issued by the Green Bay Police Department for any hunter that discharges a firearm which results in pellets landing on houses or in the park.
- 6. The hunting hours(shooting times) each day will remain as established by DNR regulations. That time is one half hour before sunrise to sunset. The hunting hours timetable will be provided.
